

ALL ARABIAN, HALF-ARABIAN & ANGLO ARABIAN EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

Please read all rules and forms before competing. Errors are costly to everyone.

1. Full entry fees must accompany your entries. Entry forms must be complete.
2. Copies of the following must accompany your entries:
 - a) current registration papers - front and back for each horse entered
 - b) lease agreement or contract of sale (if applicable)
 - c) membership cards - AHA for each owner, rider, handler, and driver - Senior & Youth
 - d) Amateur status (if applicable)
3. Parent/Guardian signature for Minors is required on all signature lines where applicable.
4. Collect calls will be made to exhibitors by the Show Manager/Secretary if deemed necessary to clarify any entry.
5. There will be a \$25.00 charge for any Returned Cheque. If the problem has not been corrected by August 1, 2012 a report will be submitted to AHA and could result in exclusion from Regional, National or other shows. A list will be kept for all other delinquent entrants for future years.
6. All horses entered in the Arabian section of this show must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, the Arabian Horse Registry of America, or the Arabian Horse Association. Any horse registered with the Canadian Partbred Arabian Horse Registry (CPAR) will NOT require a CPAR permit to show at a recognized Arabian show.
7. Combined ownership is not allowed in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the immediate family. See the Glossary in Book A for the definition of "immediate family".

The following are eligible to compete at this AHA recognized show.

1. All riders, drivers, owners, lessees, agents, or trainers who are members of AHA.
2. Any AHA individual participating in this show must be a member of AHA in good standing. Entries need to be accompanied by a copy of the AHA membership card with legible number and year.
4. Temporary memberships can be purchased for AHA (Single Event Memberships). These memberships would only be in effect for this show and do not carry forward to any other show or with any yearly award points. Affidavits for AHA are no longer allowed. If you do not have a current membership card, then you will be required to purchase a Single Event Membership for each show that you enter. Temporary memberships are NOT allowed at the Regional, Western Canadian Breeders or National Level.
5. All exhibitors over the age of 18 competing in Amateur classes must be eligible for Amateur status as described in the current AHA Rule Book. The Amateur status must be applied and paid for each year along with your membership.
6. Any person who has not reached their 18th birthday by December 31st of 2013 is regarded as an Amateur and is called a YOUTH. Youth exhibitors must also have a current membership in AHA (if 10 years of age or over). Youth exhibitors must have signatures of Parent or Guardian on the entry form in all signature areas.
7. ATR – Exhibitors must meet the specifications for amateur status.
8. **LEAD LINE - Helmets must be worn! Saddle must fit the rider, feet must be in the stirrups.**

CHECKLIST

1. Enclose - copies of all Memberships Cards if applicable.
2. Enclose - copies of Horse Registration Papers if applicable.
3. Complete the Entry Form in Full. If more than one horse is entered on the same form, make sure that all horses are OWNED by the same owner as shown on the registration papers.
4. Sign all signature lines on the BACK of the Entry Forms. No Youth Signatures allowed.
5. Enclosed full payment with the entry. No post dated payments will be accepted.
